KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

We are seeking a passionate and child-centred, Therapeutic Practitioner who will provide tailored therapeutic support for participants on our programme who are at risk of school exclusion through a creative and relational approach through our virtual and school based programmes.

The ideal candidate will work with a caseload of up to 20 students throughout the week working alongside qualified teachers, behavioural specialists, youth workers and will be willing to advocate for the most vulnerable young people in our society. In light of the challenges created by Covid-19, the ideal candidate will be digitally competent and confident in delivering sessions digitally as well as in person.

As part of the role, you will also be provided with fortnightly supervision by experienced Psychotherapists on our team. It is a dynamic and varied role that requires commitment, passion, knowledge, experience and flexibility to adapt digitally to improving outcomes for our young people in boroughs across London and Manchester.

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum Level 3 and above qualification in Child and Adolescent Counselling / Psychotherapy

- Have a passion for using football as a tool for engaging young people
